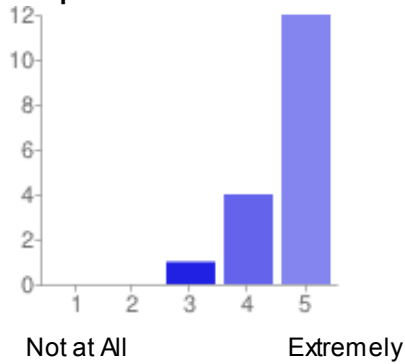

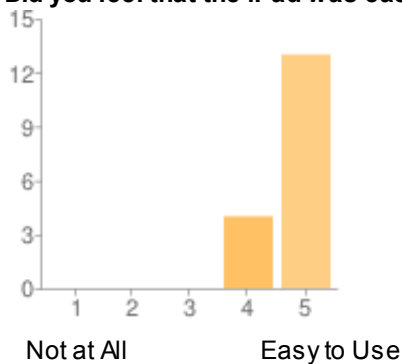

Compared to traditional lecture instruction, do you feel the iBook conveyed the material better?



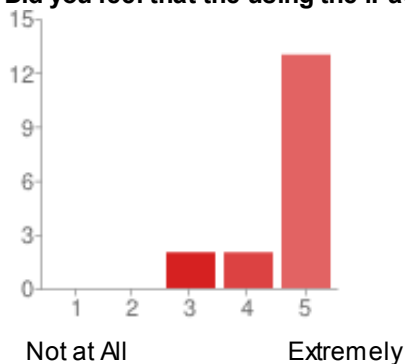

Did you feel that the iPad was easy to use?



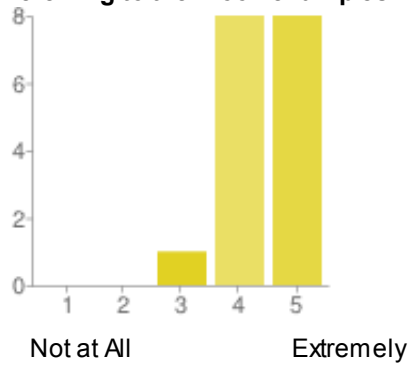

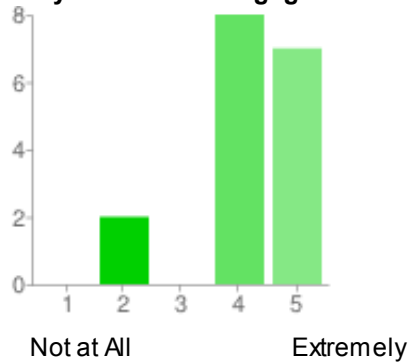

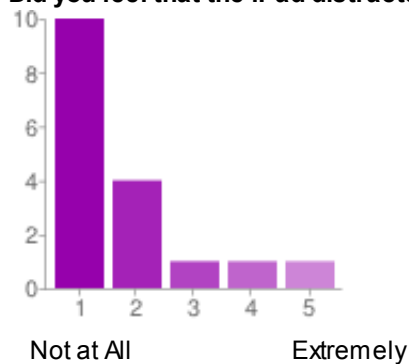

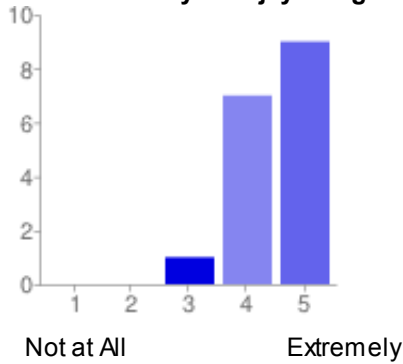

If you felt the iPad was distracting, why did you feel it distracted you?

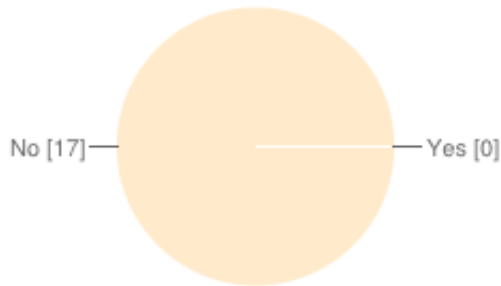

How much did you enjoy using the iPads?



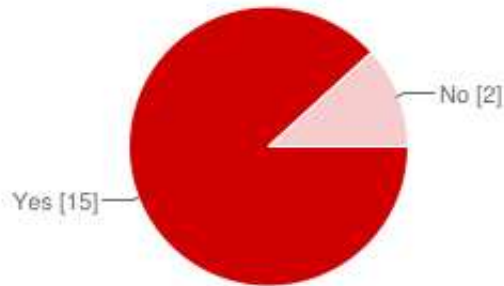
